**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA APPROVING SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN LUIS POLICE DEPARTMENT AND STATE OF ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO RECEIVE FUNDS FOR OVERTIME, AND MILEAGE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$191,400.00.**

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis Police Department desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Arizona Department of Homeland Security to increase police presence within our city limits; and

WHEREAS, the San Luis Police Department is accepting Homeland Security overtime funding for officers and reimbursement of mileage for usage of city police vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of San Luis City Council as follows:

THAT the San Luis Police Department is authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement between the City of San Luis and the Department of Homeland Security to accept funding; and

THAT the city administration shall not consider this supplanting funding when preparing, reviewing or modifying the police department's budget; and

THAT all monies received shall be for the sole purpose of supporting the priority mission of anti-terrorism, detection, arrest, prosecution, deterrence and intelligence gathering related to all cross border illicit trafficking.
