A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 8, 1994; AND ORDERING THE RECORDING OF SUCH RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona did cause to be submitted to the qualified electors of the City at a primary election held in and for the City on the 8th day of March, 1994 for the nomination of a Mayor and three Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the city council and passed Resolution No. 288, which is to be modified pursuant to Order for Yuma County Superior Court Judge H. Stewart Bradshaw.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona as follows:

Section 1. That Resolution No. 288 is replaced in its entirety with this resolution;

Section 2. That the total number of ballots issued at said primary election was 627.

Section 3. That the total number of ballots cast at said primary election as shown by the poll lists was 617;

Section 4. That the total number of questioned ballots cast and used at said primary election was 0, and that voters found to be ineligible were 1;

Section 5. That the total number of rejected ballots for the mayoral race was 8 and the total number of rejected ballots for the City Council race was 10;

Section 6. That the votes cast for Mayor were as follows:

Section 9. That Section 2-3-1 of the Code of the City of San Luis, Arizona, pursuant to authority granted from Arizona Revised Statute 9-821.01, provides that at a primary election a candidate who receives a majority of all votes cast shall be declared to be elected. That 309 votes were needed for the election of a councilmember at the primary. That no candidate for the office of City Council received a plurality of votes.

Section 10. That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record that the following six candidates for City Council did receive the next greatest number of votes of the electors of the City voting at said election and shall have their names placed on the ballot for the general election to be held on the 17th day of May, 1994, and are hereby issued certificates of nomination:

Section 11. That all orders or resolutions in conflict be and the same are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, and that this resolution be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
