A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE 2002 COMPREHENSIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY PREPARED BY THE WESTERN ARIZONA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AND SUPPORTING THE DESIGNATION OF THE WESTERN ARIZONA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AS A FEDERALLY DESIGNATED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT FOR THE COUNTIES OF YUMA, LA PAZ, AND MOHAVE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Luis has deemed that community and economic development is a priority; and


WHEREAS, the designation of the Western Arizona Economic Development District (WAEDD) as a federally designated Economic Development District, and the adoption of the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) for 2002, prepared by the Western Arizona Economic Development District, as the Regional Economic Development Strategy, are important components in pursuing community and economic development in the City of San Luis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Luis hereby adopts the WAEDD 2002 CEDS as its Regional Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy and concurs that the WAEDD 2002 CEDS shall be the Regional Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy for The Western Arizona Economic Development District, consisting of Yuma, La Paz, and Mohave Counties; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Luis hereby requests and supports the designation of the Western Arizona Economic Development District as a federally designated Economic Development District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Luis does hereby request that the Governor of the State of Arizona support the approval of the 2002 WAEDD CEDS and the designation of the Western Arizona Economic Development District as the federally designated Economic Development District for Yuma, La Paz, and Mohave Counties.
