RESOLUTION NO. 563

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS AMENDING THE CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY PLAN OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING A RESTRUCTURING OF CERTAIN DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY; ELIMINATING CERTAIN POSITIONS; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas in order to provide for the most efficient delivery of service to the citizens of the City of San Luis, it has been determined that certain amendments to the Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis and a restructuring of the Departments of City Administrator, Public Works, Economic Development, Finance, Parks and Recreation, and Senior Center, has become immediately necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS:

Section 1: The Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis is hereby amended by repealing and deleting from the Position Classification Plan the positions of Assistant City Administrator; Deputy City Clerk/Executive Staff Assistant; Parks and Recreation Director; Senior Center Director; Economic Development Director; and Office Support Specialist for the Department of Economic Development. That by this amendment these job positions are hereby eliminated from the city service effective as of the effective date of this resolution.

Section 2: The Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis is hereby amended by reassigning of the all other positions of the Senior Center to the Department of Social Services, and the functions and services of the Senior Center shall be directed

and managed by the Department of Social Services. Said positions shall be transferred and assigned to the Department of Social Services effective as of the effective date of this resolution.

Section 3: The Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis is hereby amended by reassigning the position of secretary to the Department of Economic Development to the Finance Department and the functions and services of grants administration shall be managed by the Finance Department. Said position shall be transferred and assigned to the Finance Department effective as of the effective date of this resolution.

Section 4: The Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis is hereby amended by reassigning the positions Administrative Assistant, Lifeguards, Maintenance Technician, recreation Coordinator, Recreation Specialist, and Swimming Pool Coordinator in the Recreation Department to the Department of Social Services and the functions and services of recreation provided by the City shall be managed by the Department of Social Services. Said positions shall be transferred and assigned to the Department of Social Services effective as of the effective date of this resolution.

Section 5: The Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis is hereby amended by reassigning and transferring the positions Parks Supervisor, Groundskeepers, and Maintenance Technicians in the Parks Department to the Public Works Department and the functions and services of the Parks Department shall be managed by the Department of Public Works. Said positions shall be transferred and assigned to the Public Works Department effective as of the effective date of this resolution.


Section 6: The Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis is hereby amended by is hereby further amended by adding to the Department of Social Services the position of Administrative Assistant which position shall not be exempt from the Fair Labor Standards Act. The salary range for this position shall be 44. This position shall be added to the city service effective as of the effective date of this resolution. A job position for this position shall be created and assigned to the Department of Social Services effective as of the effective date of this resolution.

Section 7: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superceded, and replaced, and the provisions of this resolution shall govern.

Section 8: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 9: Whereas, it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of San Luis, Arizona, and for further reason that the services to the citizens of the City of San Luis may be provided in the most efficient manner possible without interruption in service, as well as financial considerations, and that the best interest of the City require the amendments to go into immediate effect, an emergency is declared to exist, and this resolution shall become immediately operative and in force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.


