## RESOLUTION NO. 576

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANLUIS, ARIZONA IN HONOR OF CHARLES URTUZUASTEGUI AND FRANK URTUZUASTEGUI, PIONEERS TO THIS AREA NOW KNOWN AS THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, YUMA COUNTY; CHANGING THE NAME OF "A" STREET TO "URTUZUASTEGUI" STREET IN A RESPECTFUL EFFORT TO RECOGNIZE THEM AS CONTRIBUTORS TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF OUR COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, Charles Urtuzuastegui and Frank Urtuzuastegui are among the pioneers and founders of the City Of San Luis, and

WHEREAS, they contributed to the economic development of this community, and

WHEREAS, they established a retail store, Charles & Frank, to serve the needs of this community since 1954, and

WHEREAS, they helped build the economic foundation of this city by investing in land and in retail establishments, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Charles Urtuzuastegui initiated the efforts to create and name Friendship Park, and


WHEREAS, Mr. Charles Urtuzuastegui was a member of the original committee to incorporate the City, and





**INFORMATION ABOUT THE URTUZUASTEGUI'S AND THEIR  
CONTRIBUTIONS TO OUR CITY.**

Information provided by Alex Urtuzuastegui.

On October 8<sup>th</sup>, 1954, Charles & Frank Urtuzuastegui opened the first store in San Luis. It was considered a five-and-dime store, similar to the dollar stores of today. The store later changed and became a department store.

Years later, their younger brother Joe joined them and opened Joe's Phillips 66 Service Station. By then, Charles & Frank Home & Auto Store opened. Joe ran both of those businesses. The service station gave room to what is now Jack in the Box.

Charles Urtuzuastegui was chairman of the committee that requested the Yuma County Board of Supervisors for a recreational park to beautify the entrance to the city by the Port. The request was approved and Friendship Park was created. It was later given to the City.

Charles Urtuzuastegui was chairman of the committee that first applied for the incorporation of San Luis to the state.

The Urtuzuastegui's have contributed to the business growth of the city through land sales or leases to existing businesses like Autozone, Barney's, National Bank, Jack in the Box, AM-PM.

The Urtuzuasteguis appreciate and thank the City Council for considering the renaming of "A" Street to "Urtuzuastegui" Street. They feel that they have been good to the community of San Luis and that the community of San Luis has been good to them.
