

AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS AND IMPLEMENT CDBG PROJECTS

RESOLUTION NO. 602

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS FOR FY 2005 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATIONS MEET THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressional mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within these applications address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, an Applicant of State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis authorize application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY 2005 CDBG funds, and authorize the Mayor to sign application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds for 1) \$407, 124.00 for a City of San Luis Public works project, of which \$251,550.00 shall be allocated for Curbs, Sidewalks, and Gutters within the city limits, and of which \$58,050.00 shall be allocated for sunshade or kiosks within the city limits, and of which \$97,524.00 shall be allocated for administration of the entire CDBG program; (2) \$96,750.00 for a City of San Luis parks project, of which \$77,400.00 shall be allocated for the refurbishment of the city's baseball

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

field, and of which \$19,350.00 shall be allocated to improve the lighting in designated city parks; (3) \$23,290.00 for a City of San Luis youth recreation project; (4) \$23,220.00 for a transportation project to assist senior citizens and/or other CDBG-eligible residents in the City of San Luis; (5) \$58,050.00 for a City of San Luis Micro-Enterprise Small Loans project that will provide revolving loan funds, in conjunction with PPEP (a 501-c-3 organization), for residents of the City of San Luis; (6) \$46,440.00 for a City of San Luis Youth Training and Employment Project, which in conjunction with PPEP (a 501-c-3 organization), shall be modeled after the Youthbuild Program to provide job skills training for income-eligible youth/young adults in the City of San Luis; (10) \$175,000.00, which is being requested from the State Special Projects (SSP) CDBG Program fund, for a "Quick Attack Truck" for the City of San Luis Fire Department, and (11) \$80,000.00 for a project to revise the city's existing zoning code and/or city ordinances, which the City of San Luis shall submit as a "back-up" or alternative project that for submission to the CDBG Regional Accounts (RA) CDBG Program Fund, and also, to the State Special Projects (SSP) Program Fund, and authorize the Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application(s); and

THAT this application for State CDBG funds meets the requirements of low-and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefiting low-and moderate-income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

THAT, the City will comply with all State CDBG Program guidelines, Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG Program and the certifications contained in these applications.


