## RESOLUTION NO. 646

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 639 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE ISSUANCE OF SAN LUIS CIVIC IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION BONDS NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF MUNICIPAL FACILITIES EXCISE TAX REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2005, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING CERTAIN OUTSTANDING OBLIGATIONS AND FINANCING CERTAIN ADDITIONAL MUNICIPAL PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, Resolution authorized the issuance of San Luis Civic Improvement municipal facilities excise tax bonds, Series 2005; and

Whereas, said Resolution at Section six approves a maximum maturity date of January 1, 2038 and the actual date needs to be July 1, 2038; and

Whereas, the San Luis Civic Improvement Corporation Municipal Facilities Excise Tax Revenue Bonds have been sold and clarification of the maximum maturity date is immediately necessary to ensure proper legality of the sale;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That the maximum maturity date for the San Luis Civic Improvement Corporation Municipal Facilities Excise Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2005 as stated in Section 6 of Resolution No.639 is hereby amended and changed to the date of July 1, 2038.

Section 2: The immediate operation of this Resolution is necessary for the financing of the Project and the preservation of the public health and welfare; an emergency is hereby declared to exist; this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona and this Resolution is hereby exempt from the referendum provisions of the Constitution and laws of the State of Arizona.



## *Resolution* RESOLUTION NO. 647

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, PROVIDING FOR A CALL OF ELECTION FOR THE 2006 PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS, DESIGNATING THE ELECTION DATES AND PURPOSE, DESIGNATING THE DEADLINE AND LOCATION FOR CANDIDATES TO FILE NOMINATION PETITIONS AND DESIGNATING THE DEADLINE FOR VOTER REGISTRATION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis Primary and General Elections for 2006 are required to be held on certain dates pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes §16-204, which are March 14, 2006 and May 16, 2006, respectively; and,

**WHEREAS**, City of San Luis elections are required in order to fill the offices of Mayor, and three City Council seats,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That March 14, 2006 has been set as the date for holding the Primary Election in the City of San Luis, Arizona, for the purpose of nominating candidates for Mayor and three (3) City Council seats whose names shall appear on the ballot at the General Election to be held on May 16, 2006. Any candidates receiving a majority of all the ballots cast at the Primary Election shall be declared elected without running at the General Election.

**SECTION 2.** That May 16, 2006 has been set as the date for holding the General Election in the City of San Luis, Arizona, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and three (3) City Council Members.

**SECTION 3.** Candidates seeking municipal office may obtain nominations papers and other materials from the Office of the City Clerk, located at San Luis City Hall, 767 N. First Avenue, beginning Monday, November 14, 2005. Candidate nomination papers are required to be filed at the Office of the City Clerk. The first day to file nomination papers and other forms is Monday November 14, 2005 and the last day to file the nomination paperwork is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 14, 2005 at the Office of the City Clerk in order for their names to appear on the Primary Election ballot. Write-In candidates filing deadline is Thursday, February 2, 2006 at 5:00 p.m.

**SECTION 4.** Yuma County registration and voting lists will be used for the Primary and General elections. In order to be qualified to vote in the Primary Election, voters must be registered by February 13, 2006. To be qualified to vote in the General Election, voters must be registered by April 17, 2006.
