## **RESOLUTION NO. 664**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COUNTY OF YUMA REPROGRAMMING \$23,290.000 IN FY 2005 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FROM A YOUTH RECREATION (CDBG #153-06) TO A CURBS, SIDEWALKS, GUTTERS AND SUNSHADES PROJECT (CDBG #149-06).**

**WHEREAS, the City of San Luis participates in the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program, and upon advice from the Arizona Department of Housing ("ADOH"), now wishes to reprogram \$23,290.00 in FY 2005 CDBG funds from CDBG Project #153-06 ("Youth Recreation") to CDBG Project #149-06 ("Curbs, Sidewalks, Gutters, and Sunshades"); and**

**WHEREAS, though publication and through a public hearing; the City of San Luis has informed the general public and other interested parties of the intended change; and**

**WHEREAS, no objection has been voiced to this proposed change;**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma hereby authorizes the reprogramming of \$23,290.00 in CDBG funds from CBDG Project #153-06 to CDBG Project #149-06 and further instructs city staff to prepare and submit the necessary documentation to ADOH to effect this change.**



**Dr. Michael Trend, Director of Community Development opened the public hearing at 7:05 p.m. Also present were Council Member Rosa I. Varela and Orenda Meraz, Administrative Assistant for the City of San Luis.**

**DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS:**

Dr. Michael Trend explained how the City of San Luis has been required by Arizona Department of Housing to reprogram \$23,290.00 of CDBG

He said that, in the absence of any objection to the reprogramming at this hearing, he would recommend to the City Council to reprogram the money from CDBG project #153-06 to CDBG project #149-06.
