A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, ADOPTING A NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INCREASE COMMERCIAL WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES AND DECREASE RESIDENTIAL WATER RATES

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of San Luis desires to provide for a more equitable system of charges for the provision of water service where residential customers do not subsidize commercial customers;


WHEREAS the City Council intends to consider adjusting water and wastewater rates for commercial customers to properly reflect a cost of service rate and to allow a fair reduced rate for residential customers without loss of revenue; and

WHEREAS wastewater rates for service to Yuma County Improvement District No. 96-7 (Townsite of Gadsden, Gadsden Estates Unit Two, and Chekash's Subdivision) need to conform to new city rates;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That the Notice of Intention to Increase Commercial Water and Wastewater Rates and Decrease Residential Water Rates as attached as Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted and approved. City Staff is hereby directed to provide notice of said Notice as may be provided by law.



NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INCREASE WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES

The City of San Luis, Arizona, ("City"), hereby gives notice of its intention to raise commercial and other non-residential water and wastewater rates. The City hereby gives further notice of its intention to raise wastewater rates to users located in Yuma County Improvement District No. 96-7 (Townsite of Gadsden, Gadsden Estates Unit Two, and Chekash's Subdivision), hereinafter referred to as the "District," in conformance with the Intergovernmental Agreement between the District and the City dated May 23, 2001, and the provisions of A.R.S. §9-511.01. The proposed increases in fees is supported by the Water, Wastewater, and Sanitation Cost of Service Survey dated February 2003 and the study conducted by Economists.Com dated August, 2006 which are available for inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, City of San Luis, 767 N. First Ave., San Luis, Arizona. A public hearing on the on the proposed rate increases will be held on Wednesday, October 25, 2006 at the Council Chambers of the City of San Luis, at 7:00 p.m., 767 N. First Ave., San Luis, Arizona.
