A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA,
DECLARING THAT CERTAIN DOCUMENT ENTITLED "2003
INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE FOR ONE- AND
TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS" COPYWRITED BY THE
INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL, INC. A PUBLIC
RECORD; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS;
AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF San
Luis:


Section 1: That the certain document entitled "2003 International Residential Code For One- And Two-Family Dwellings" copywrited by the International Code Council, Inc., three (3) copies of which are on file with the City Clerk of the City of San Luis, is hereby made and declared a public record of the City of San Luis, Arizona, and made a part hereof as though fully set forth again in full.

Section 2: In adopting this resolution, it is the intent of the City Council of the City of San Luis that the "2003 International Residential Code For One- And Two-Family Dwellings" specifically apply only to the construction activities and structures covered only by that code and not apply to any other form of construction or development activity. It is the intent of the City Council of the City of San Luis that the other existing building and construction codes of the City of San Luis apply to all other types of structures, construction and development.

Section 3: Subject to the provisions of Section 2 above, in the event of a conflict between the provisions of this resolution or the "2003 Residential Dwelling Code For One- And Two-Family Dwellings" and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this resolution and/or the "2003 Residential Code For One- And Two-Family Dwellings" shall govern.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this resolution or the "2003 Residential Code For One- And Two-Family Dwellings" is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution or said code.


