Resolution **RESOLUTION NO. 791**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 621 AND GIVING POLICY DIRECTION TO CITY STAFF REGARDING COLLECTION OF WATER AND WASTEWATER CONNECTION FEES AND COLLECTION OF DEVELOPMENT FEES

Whereas, the City Council of the City of San Luis adopted wastewater (sewer) connection fees and service line and meter installation charges for water service pursuant to Ordinance No. 132 of the City of San Luis on January 24, 1996;

Whereas, the City Council of the City of San Luis added Article 6-7 Impact Fees to the City Code pursuant to Ordinance No. 197, on May 14, 2003, which established and implemented Development Fees pursuant to the authority granted pursuant to Title 9 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, said ordinance establishing the amount of fees to be assessed at Section 6-7-9, which amount currently remains in force and effect;

Whereas, the City Council of the City of San Luis in 2005 did not wish to have the citizens and property owners of the City suffer due to erroneous conclusions of a previous administration, adopted Resolution No. 621 which gave a policy direction regarding collection without amending the rates and fees that had been previously established; and

Whereas an appropriate period of time has passed to alleviate any possible harm created by administrative practices which existed between 2003 and 2005;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, as follows:

Section 1: That Resolution No. 621 of the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, Giving Policy Direction to City Staff Regarding Collection of Water and Wastewater Connection Fees and Collection of Development Fees is hereby repealed..

Section 2: That it is the policy and direction of the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona that the fees and charges established by Ordinance Nos. 132 and 197 are to be collected in full.


