**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA ALLOCATING UP TO \$35,000.00 IN CITY OF SAN LUIS FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE YOUTH TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT PROJECT WITH PPEP, INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2007/2008 Youth Training and Employment Project by PPEP, Inc. has successfully imparted construction skills to several low-income youth who are residents of the City of San Luis, Arizona, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis funding for that effort has been expended, and

**WHEREAS**, the San Luis City Council wishes to continue the program to the benefit of income-eligible participating San Luis youths and has allocated funds in its budget for that purpose;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the San Luis City Council extends its existing agreement with PPEP, Inc. and authorizes up to \$35,000.00 in City of San Luis funds to continue the program until June 30, 2009 or until the funding has been expended.
