**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COUNTY OF YUMA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS FOR FY 2008/2009 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATIONS MEET THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Arizona Development Block Grant Program is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of three Congressionally mandated National Objectives; and

**WHEREAS**, the activities within these applications address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low and moderate income persons; and

**WHEREAS**, an Applicant of State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma authorize application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY 2008/2009 funds, and authorize the Mayor to sign application and contract or grant documents for \$300,000.00 of State Special Project (SSP) funds for a City of San Luis Public works project; and

**THAT** this application for State CDBG funds meets the requirements of low- and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefiting low- and moderate-income persons, or aiding in the prevention or elimination of slum and light, or addressing an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

**THAT** the City of San Luis will comply with all State CDBG Program Guidelines, Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG Program and the certifications contained in these applications.


