A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, SELECTING THE FY 2009 REGIONAL ACCOUNT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROJECTS AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO PREPARE APPLICATIONS FOR SAME AND SUBMIT SUCH APPLICATIONS THROUGH WESTERN ARIZONA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING FOR FUNDING AS CDBG REGIONAL ACCOUNT PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis participates in the Community Development Block Grant Program and desires to apply for, receive, and expend its FY 2009 CDBG Regional Account Allocation for the benefit of eligible individuals and households residing within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona Community Development Block Grant program requires that an applicant requesting CDBG funds adopt a resolution certifying that the appropriate public officials, after soliciting public input and after due deliberation, select one or more projects that, in their judgment, best meet the needs of the City of San Luis and its residents: and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has met all requirements concerning project solicitation, public review, and publication:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of San Luis selects, in addition to funding for Project Administration, three projects from the list below, at the indicated funding levels, with the remaining projects being rank ordered as alternative projects, for submission to the State of Arizona and the City further instructs staff to prepare and submit the necessary applications for funding of same projects in a cumulative amount not to exceed \$573,343.00 from the following list:

Project Administration	\$57,334.00
Update of General Plan	\$85,000.00
Rehabilitation of the West Wastewater Treatment Plant Sludge Beds	\$200,000.00

Rehabilitation of Joe Orduno Gym

\$231,009.00
