RESOLUTION NO. 890

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS TO THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ADOT) FOR SECTION 1303 COORDINATED BORDER INFRASTRUCTURE (CBI) FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF VARIOUS STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN LUIS.

WHEREAS, the Transportation/Circulation Plan of the City of San Luis General Plan (2002) identifies the street network and classifications within the City of San Luis; and,

WHEREAS, the Transportation/Circulation Goals, Objectives, and Policies of the City of San Luis General Plan (2002) include working closely with federal, state, local, and regional funding entities to ensure transportation improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis Capital Improvement Plan 2009 identifies the categories and priorities of various street projects within the City of San Luis; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis Small Area Transportation Study (2009) identifies various recommendations for street projects within the City of San Luis; and,

WHEREAS, the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO) Regional Transportation Plan (2010) identifies the need for various street projects within the City of San Luis; and,

WHEREAS, these various studies confirm and recommend these various projects located within 100 miles of the US/Mexico Border;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis as follows:

SECTION 1: That the submission of applications to the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) for Section 1303 Coordinated Border Infrastructure (CBI) federal grant funds for the improvement of various streets within the City of San Luis be authorized;


SECTION 2: That the application is certified to be consistent and compatible with all adopted plans and programs of the City of San Luis General Plan (2002), City of San Luis Small Area Transportation Study (2009), and the YMPO Regional Transportation Plan (2010);

SECTION 3: That the City of San Luis agrees to comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by the Arizona Department of Transportation as part of the application process;

SECTION 4: that the City of San Luis certifies that it will comply with all appropriate State and Federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application;

SECTION 5: That the City Administrator or designee is authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, application, agreements, contracts, and amendments which may be necessary for the project.


