A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE PRELIMINARY STEPS TO BE TAKEN TO BECOME A PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER IN THE ELECTED OFFICIALS' RETIREMENT PLAN ON BEHALF OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Elected Officials' Retirement Plan has been created by the State of Arizona to provide retirement and other benefits for elected officials; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of said Elected Officials' Retirement Plan, it is optional for an incorporated city or town to include within said system its elected officials; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the City of to include its' elected officials under the Arizona Elected Officials' Retirement Plan as prescribed by Title 38, Chapter 5, Article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes as amended; and

WHEREAS, by the adoption of this resolution, the City hereby presently commits to providing this benefit to its officials during fiscal year 2012/2013;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona .as follows:


Section 1: It is hereby authorized and requested that a preliminary actuarial survey be made to determine the estimated cost of participation in the Elected Officials Retirement Plan, the benefits to be derived, and such other information as may be deemed appropriate, the cost of said survey to be paid by the City of San Luis.

Section 2: The City Manager and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to provide and turn over such records as are necessary to make the actuarial survey.

Section 3: The City Manager and city staff are hereby authorized and directed to take whatever steps are needed or necessary to carry out and effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4: The City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Trustees of the Elected Officials' Retirement Plan.


