A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, AZ, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION AND EXECUTION OF A PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ADOT) SAFETEA-LU TRANSPORTATION ACT ENHANCEMENT GRANT FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BICYCLE/WALKING PATH ALONG THE EAST MAIN CANAL BETWEEN SAN LUIS HIGH SCHOOL AND THE SAN LUIS BRANCH OF THE YUMA COUNTY LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, the Circulation Element of the San Luis General Plan (2020) states in Goal #1 Objective E: Improve pedestrian safety through the construction of new walkways; and

WHEREAS, the Circulation Element of the San Luis General Plan (2020) states in Goal #3 objective C: Create needed connections between schools and activity areas; and

WHEREAS, building a lighted all weather walking/bicycle path between San Luis High School and the library is both sensible and desirable; and

WHEREAS, procedures established by ADOT require the applicant to certify by Resolution: the grant application, signatures, authorizations, availability of local matching funds, and authorization to sign a participant agreement

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis, AZ as follows:

THAT the filling of an application for Transportation Enhancement Funds is hereby approved;

THAT the application is certified to be consistent and compatible with all adopted plans and programs of the City's 2020 General Plan.

THAT the City of San Luis agrees to comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by the Arizona Department of Transportation as part of the application process including ADOT review fees;

THAT the City of San Luis certifies that it will comply with all appropriate State and Federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application;

THAT the City of San Luis Commits to a 5.7% match and any overmatch;

THAT the City of San Luis commits to funding the project scoping document, environmental, right-of-way and utility clearances and design, if applicable;

THAT the City of San Luis commits to be ready for advertisement in three years from the date of execution of a contract; to pay for all cost overruns upon review and approval by the City Council; and to reimburse ADOT/FHWA for all Federal funds used, if the project is cancelled by the City prior to its completion;

THAT the City Administrator and the designees are authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to: application, agreements, contracts, and amendments that may be necessary for the project.


