A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS SUPPORTING THE LOCATION OF PRISON FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF LUIS, ARIZONA BY THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

Whereas the State of Arizona, by and through the Arizona Department of Corrections has made a Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 120088DC for 2000 Medium Security Prison Beds;

Whereas in response to said Request for Proposal, several providers have submitted bids proposing that facilities be located within the municipal limits of the City of San Luis;

Whereas the State of Arizona began operating a state prison complex in Yuma County in 1986 and said facilities now house approximately 2,300 inmates within the municipal limits of the City of San Luis, and has been in the municipal limits of the City since 2001;

Whereas the City of San Luis through the San Luis Development Corporation owns and operates the San Luis Regional Detention Facility which houses approximately 400 detainees, and has operated this facility since 2007;


Whereas the City of San Luis is a community of approximately 28,000 residents and has, historically, an unemployment rate of 40 percent;

Whereas the corrections industry brings employment and welcome economic impact to the community of San Luis; and

Whereas the Arizona Department of Corrections has scheduled a public hearing in San Luis regarding Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 120088DC;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis that the City welcomes the State of Arizona, Department of Corrections to the City of San Luis, and expresses support for an award of contract that locates the prison facilities proposed by Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 120088DC within the municipal limits of the City of San Luis.
