RESOLUTION NO. 992

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS AMENDING THE CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY PLAN OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSITION OF FINANCE DIRECTOR; CONVERTING THE POSTION FROM A CONTRACT POSITION TO ONE IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

Whereas in order to provide for the most efficient delivery of service to the citizens of the City of San Luis, it has been determined that certain amendments to the Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis has become necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS:

Section 1: The Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis is hereby amended by adding the position of Finance Director at the salary range of 94. The City Manager is hereby directed to prepare a job description for the position and is further directed to include as minimum qualification that of being a certified public accountant with a minimum of three years experience in local government accounting.

Section 2: Ketic St. Louis is to be retained as the Finance Director of the City of San Luis under the Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis in accordance with the provisions of section one hereinabove. It is the intent of the City Council that by this resolution, the position of contract employee is to be converted to that of a position under the Classification and Salary Plan of the City of San Luis. As a result, her existing contract with the City of San Luis dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2007 is hereby terminated effective as of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2012. The City Manager is hereby

directed to take such actions as may be needed to effectuate this resolution.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this resolution shall govern.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.


