WHEREAS, Kathryn "Casey" Prochaska, who serves as the Yuma County Supervisor for District 3, will leave the Yuma County Board of Supervisors after outstanding and meritorious service to Yuma County and the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Prochaska, a visionary and respected leader with twenty years of elected service has an extensive background as a government leader. 
