A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE PREPARATION AND SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION'S WATERSMART PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF UPGRADING WELL SITE PUMPS AND ACHIEVING ENERGY COST SAVINGS AND IMPROVED PUMPING CAPACITY AND PERFORMANCE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council are committed to energy efficient operation of City facilities and services, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council are committed to operating City facilities and services in a cost effective and efficient manner, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation's WaterSMART grant program offers an opportunity for the City to replace energy inefficient pumps at the City well sites with higher capacity and more efficient pumps;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of San Luis City Council authorizes its staff to prepare and submit an application to the Bureau of Reclamation's WaterSMART program for grant funds to replace and upgrade pumps at the City well sites, and that Mayor Gerardo Sanchez is authorized to sign all applications and documents related to this grant, and that the City of San Luis will work with the Bureau of Reclamation to meet established deadlines for entering into a cooperative agreement.


