A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COMMITTING UP TO \$150,000.00 IN MATCHING FUNDS FOR A BUREAU OF RECLAMATION WATERSMART GRANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING EXISTING ENERGY INEFFICIENT AND LOS CAPACITY WELL SITE PUMPS WITH NEW ENERGY EFFICIENT AND HIGHER CAPACITY PUMPS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council are committed to energy efficient operation of City facilities and services, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council are committed to operating City facilities and services in a cost effective and efficient manner, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation's WaterSMART grant program offers an opportunity for the City to replace energy inefficient pumps at the City well sites with higher capacity and more efficient pumps, and

WHEREAS, to receive the grant moneys requested and hoped for, the City must provide a minimum of 50% in matching funds, and the City has the capability to so provide these matching funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of San Luis City Council commits up to \$150,000 in funds from water system revenues and/or impact fees, as necessary and appropriate, as matching funds for a Bureau of Reclamation WaterSMART grant, for which the City is applying.

Passed and adopted by the City of San Luis this 9th day of January 2013.




