A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, RATIFYING THAT THE CITY OF SAN LUIS POLICE DEPARTMENT RECEIVE FUNDING FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY FOR THE IMPAIRED DRIVER/DUI ALCOHOL ENFORCEMENT, STEP/SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT, AND OCCUPANT PROTECTION PROGRAMS IN THE AMOUNT TOTALING \$13,200.00.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA;

WHEREAS, in an effort to eradicate drivers under the influence, speed violators, and traffic fatalities; the San Luis Police Department is constantly seeking funding to implement special enforcement programs and equipment from the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety awarded the City of San Luis Police Department the amount of \$13,200.00 to support additional overtime and employee related expenses and the purchase of capital outlay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the San Luis City Council as follows:

1. THAT the San Luis Police Department be authorized to enter into a contract with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety to receive \$5,000.00 to support additional overtime and employee related expenses enhancing DUI Alcohol Enforcement under GOHS Contract No. 2015-AL-010;
2. THAT the San Luis Police Department be authorized to enter into a contract with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety to receive \$5,000.00 to support additional overtime and employee related expenses enhancing Speed Enforcement under GOHS Contract No. 2015-PT-038;
3. THAT the San Luis Police Department be authorized to enter into a contract with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety to receive \$3,200.00 to support the purchase of Capital Outlay: child safety seats to enhance Occupant Protection under GOHS Contract No. 2015-OP-021;
4. THAT the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into said agreement on behalf of the City of San Luis and the Chief of Police is hereby directed to take any and all actions as may be necessary to effectuate said agreement;


