A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 600 REGARDING THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES BY MAKING PROVISION FOR GARAGE SALES; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona has provided for a business license tax pursuant to Ordinance No. 229 of the City of San Luis, Arizona, said provisions being contained at Chapter 110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of San Luis ("City Code"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Luis has established the fee schedule for occupational licenses in Resolution No. 600 of the City of San Luis, Arizona; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of San Luis desires to make specific provision within said fee schedule for garage sales;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

Section 1: That Section 1 subsection B of Resolution 600 of the City of San Luis, Arizona is hereby amended to add to the list of specified business the category of Garage Sales which shall read as follows:

Garage sales


\$0, however all persons conducting a garage sale must be properly registered with the City prior to conducting said sale.

Section 2: Any fee, tax, rate or charge contained in Resolution No. 600 of the City of San Luis, Arizona not specifically amended by this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superceded, and replaced, and the provisions of this resolution shall govern.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.


