A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A PLANNING ASSISTANCE FOR RURAL AREAS (PARA) GRANT APPLICATION TO THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ADOT) FOR A BORDER PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE ACCESS STUDY THAT WILL BE UNDERTAKEN WITH THE OVERSIGHT AND COOPERATION OF THE YUMA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (YMPO).

WHEREAS, the San Luis I Port of Entry lacks adequate infrastructure for pedestrian and bicycle crossing; and

WHEREAS, the lack of suitable infrastructure complicates the travel experience and translate into an overall reduction in commercial and other economic activity in the San Luis, Arizona area; and

WHEREAS the lack of improvements result in negative environmental impacts, most notably in the form of increased air pollution from idling automobile engines and greenhouse gas emissions; and


WHEREAS, if more is known about suitable infrastructure, effective actions may be undertaken to provide a safer, easier and more comfortable border crossing; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis is about to undertake a costly program of street and traffic improvements in the vicinity of the San Luis Port of Entry 1 that can benefit from additional knowledge of border pedestrian and bicycle safety crossing; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis will conduct a pedestrian and bicycle access study under the oversight and with the cooperation of the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO);

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona that it supports the undertaking of a bicycle and pedestrian access study for San Luis Port of Entry 1 and authorizes staff to prepare a grant application for the study and to submit it forthwith to the Arizona Department of Transportation for its consideration.
