BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA;


WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice is seeking proposals from state and local agencies for projects to hire and/or rehire career law enforcement officers in an effort to increase their community policing capacity and crime prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona through the San Luis Police Department, is interested in submitting projects to be considered for funding in the form of reimbursable grants from the U.S. Department of Justice (COPS);


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the San Luis City Council as follows:

1. THAT approval of the submission of projects for consideration in the U.S. Department of Justice 2015 Community Oriented Policing Services is granted;
2. THAT Chief of Police or designee is appointed agent for the City of San Luis, Arizona, to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.
