

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF WARRANTS PURSUANT TO A.R.S. SECTION 42-313.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of A.R.S. Section 42-313, the Town of San Luis is authorized to provide for the issuance of warrants in payment of necessary expenses, with the warrants to be redeemed when the funds become available in the next fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That whenever the Town of San Luis is indebted upon an account, upon approval for payment of such indebtedness by the Common Council of the Town of San Luis by motion noted in the minutes of a regular or special meeting, the Mayor and Town Clerk are authorized to issue warrants upon the Town Treasurer for the amount due. Not more than one warrant shall be drawn for the amount allowed. The warrant shall be drawn in favor of the person to whom it is due, and warrant shall be substantially in the following form:
