

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, SETTING FORTH UNLAWFUL CONDUCT AND ESTABLISHING THE PENALTIES THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA:

Section 1: BURNING

It is unlawful for any person to start or maintain any open fire for the purpose of burning trash or rubbish in any of the streets, alleys or vacant lots in the town, or to start or maintain any such fire in the yards or enclosures surrounding any dwelling house or business property situated therein.

Section 2: INTERFERENCE

It is unlawful for any person, other than the owner, manager or his authorized representative, to interfere individually or collectively with free enjoyment of such property by the owners thereof; or interfere with the conduct of any lawful business by obstructing entrance to such business or by obstructing free passage of persons or merchandise or commodities within such place of business, or by obstructing service rendered by such business to its customers.

Section 3: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN A MOTOR VEHICLE

- A. No person shall drink any alcoholic beverage while in a motor vehicle upon a street or highway within the Town limits.
- B. No person shall have in his possession on his person while driving a motor vehicle upon a street or highway, within the Town limits, any bottle, can, or other receptacle containing any alcoholic beverage which has been opened, or seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed.
- C. No person shall have in his possession, while in a motor vehicle upon a street or a highway, within the Town limits, any bottle, can, or other receptacle, containing any alcoholic beverage which has been opened, or a seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed.

D. It is unlawful for the registered owner of any motor vehicle, or the driver if the registered owner is not then present in the vehicle, to keep in a motor vehicle, when such vehicle is upon a street or highway, within the Town limits, any bottle, can, or other receptacle containing any alcoholic beverage which has been opened, or a seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed, unless such container is kept in the trunk of the vehicle, or kept in some other area of the vehicle not normally occupied by the driver or passengers, if the vehicle is not equipped with a trunk. A utility compartment or glove compartment shall be deemed to be within the area occupied by the driver and passengers.


Section 4:

Upon conviction for violation of any section contained within this Ordinance, the sentence to be imposed shall be a fine of not more than \$500.00 or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.
