

ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER ONE BY CHANGING THE DAY TO CONDUCT REGULAR MEETINGS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA:

Section 1:


That section number one (1) of Ordinance number one (1) shall be amended to read as follows:

The Council shall hold regular meetings on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month at seven-thirty o'clock p.m., provided that when the day fixed for any regular meeting of the Council falls upon a day designated by law as a legal holiday, such meeting shall be held at the same hour on the next succeeding day not a holiday. All regular meetings of the Council shall be held at the Town Hall known as the Yuma County Sheriff's Sub-Station in San Luis, Arizona.


WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage by the Town Council, approval by the Mayor, publication and posting as required by law.
