

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, PROHIBITING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM CITY PARKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA; AND ESTABLISHING THE PENALTY THEREFORE.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 : It shall be unlawful for any person, while on the premises of any city park in San Luis, Arizona to commit any of the following acts:


- A. Drink or have in his possession any alcoholic beverage.
- B. Have in his possession any bottle, can, or other receptacle containing any alcoholic beverage which has been opened, its seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed.

Section 2 : Upon conviction for violation of any section of this Ordinance, the sentence to be imposed shall be a fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or both.
