

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, SETTING FORTH THE PROVISION FOR CLOSING OF SAN LUIS TOWN PARKS: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

For the promotion and protection of the public health, safety, convenience and general welfare, of the citizens and residents of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, the San Luis Town Council hereby adopts an ordinance to close Friendship Park, and other Town parks, as the aforementioned considerations may warrant and apply, in order to provide for the safekeeping of Friendship Park, and other Town parks.

Section 2.

This ordinance is hereby adopted in order to give full legal force and effect to San Luis Town Ordinance No. 18, passed and adopted by the San Luis Town Council on September 23rd, 1981.

Section 3. - Declaration of an Emergency


