

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 23; ESTABLISHING A TOWN CODE FOR THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS; AND SETTING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE TOWN CODE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 23 is amended by deleting Sections 1 and 2 , and inserting the following:

Section 1.

For the promotion and protection of the public health, safety, convenience and general welfare, of the citizens and residents of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, the San Luis Town Council hereby adopts by ordinance and establishes a Town Code for the Town of San Luis, Arizona.


Section 2.


Any person found guilty of violating any provision of the code shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days or by a fine not exceeding the sum of \$500.00, or both, as provided for in the Arizona Revised Statutes.


Section 3. - Declaration of an Emergency

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative and in force on and after the date of adoption by the Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona.
