

ORDINANCE No. 36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 2-4-1 OF ARTICLE 2-4 OF THE TOWN CODE, BY CHANGING THE TIME OF THE MEETINGS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA:

Section 1

That section 2-4-1 of Article 2-4 of the Town Code shall be amended to read as follows:

The Council shall hold regular meetings on the second and fourth Saturday of each month at two o'clock p.m., provided that when the day fixed for any regular meeting of the Council falls upon a day designed by law as a legal holiday, such meeting shall be held at the same hour on the next succeeding day not a holiday. All regular meetings of the Council shall be held at the Town Hall, Town Council Chambers, 23222 First Street, San Luis, Arizona.


