

AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 4, SECTION 4-1-5,
DUTIES OF POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO ALLOW A PROVISION ALLOWING
A PEACE OFFICER OR DULY AUTHORIZED AGENT TO STOP, DETAIN
AND INVESTIGATE VIOLATORS OF THE TRAFFIC CODE OF SAN LUIS,
AND A.R.S. TITLE 28, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLES 20 and 21, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS,
ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:


That the Town Council of San Luis, does hereby amend
the San Luis Town Code, Article 4-1-5, by adding as follows:

Section 4-1-5 H: DUTIES OF POLICE DEPARTMENT.

Any peace officer or duly authorized agent
of the Town of San Luis, may stop and detain a
person as is reasonably necessary to investigate
an actual or suspected violation of Chapter 11 and
12 of this Code, A.R.S. Title 28, Chapter 6,
Article 20 and 21, and to serve a copy of the
traffic complaint for any alleged civil or criminal
violation of said Articles.


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation
of the peace, health and safety of the Town of San Luis,
an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be
effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

1984.


