

AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 12-2 METHOD OF PARKING TOWN CODE OF SAN LUIS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A CIVIL SANCTION RATHER THAN A CRIMINAL PENALTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:


That the Town Council of San Luis, does hereby amend the San Luis Town Code, Section 12-2 Blocking Traffic:

A. It is a violation for any person to stop, stand, or park any motor vehicle or their vehicle upon a street in the town in such manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than twenty feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, except that a person may stop temporarily, in the actual loading or unloading of passengers or, when necessary, in the observance of traffic signs or signals of the police chief.

B. It is a violation for any person to park a motor vehicle, or other vehicle, within an alley or entrance to a private driveway except for when the loading or unloading can be accomplished without blocking the alley to the free movement of vehicular traffic.


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of San Luis, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Common Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, this 22nd day of Febrary 1984.


