

AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 12-5 PARKING VEHICLES ON SIDEWALKS, TOWN CODE FOR SAN LUIS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A CIVIL SANCTION RATHER THAN A CRIMINAL PENALTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the Town Council of San Luis, does hereby amend the San Luis Town Code, Section 12-5, Parking Vehicles on Sidewalks, as follows:


It is a violation for any Person to park any vehicle, whether in usable condition or not, or for an owner to permit his vehicle to be parked upon any sidewalk in the Town.


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of San Luis, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
