

ORDINANCE 70

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, FINDING AND DECLARING THAT ALL REFERENCES TO THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS SHALL BE CHANGED AND HEREAFTER KNOWN AS THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 2-1-1 ELECTED OFFICERS OF THE CITY CODE AND 2-2-1 SELECTION OF MAYOR TO ALLOW THE MAYOR TO BE ELECTED DIRECTLY BY THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA.

Section 1: At the last election the residents of San Luis, Arizona approved the change of city government from the Town of San Luis to the City of San Luis.

Section 2: That effective from the date of that election any reference to the Town of San Luis shall be changed to the City of San Luis.

Section 3: That after the last election, of the residents San Luis, Arizona approved the election of the Mayor by direct vote of the electors; and in furtherance of that, Section 2-1-1 and 2-2-1 are repealed and replaced with the following:


Section 2-1-1 Elected Officers

Elected officers of the City shall be seven councilmen, one of whom shall be elected directly by the electors as Mayor in accordance with Section 2-2-1. The terms of office for Councilmen shall be staggered terms as set forth in the Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-272 and by such resolutions as the Council may adopt and a candidate can not run for both Mayor and Councilman at the same election.

Section 2-2-1 Election of Mayor

The qualified electors of the City of San Luis shall directly elect the Mayor.


