

ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, RELATING TO THE PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAX: ADOPTING "THE 1990 AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY TAX CODE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA" BY REFERENCE AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That certain document known as "The 1990 Amendments to the City Code of the City of San Luis, Arizona", three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of San Luis, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 203 of the City of San Luis, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

SECTION 2: The provisions of this ordinance and the public record adopted herein are effective on August 1, 1990.


SECTION 3: Any person found guilty of violating any provision of these amendments to the tax code shall be guilty of a class one misdemeanor. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offence punished as herein above described.

SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance or any part of these amendments to the tax code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, the immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of San Luis, Arizona and this ordinance shall become immediately operative and in force from and after the posting hereof.
