

ORDINANCE NO. 94

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CITY TAX CODE TO INCREASE THE TAX RATE TO TWO AND ONE-HALF PERCENT (2.5%) ON ALL TAXABLE TRANSACTIONS; AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE ON OCTOBER 1, 1991

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, YUMA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The tax rate increase of one-half percent (.5%) is needed to assist the City with future capital improvements and retirement of debt incurred for the purchase of capital improvements and the City will use reasonable efforts to use the increase for these purposes.

SECTION 2: The tax rate in each of the following sections of the City tax code is hereby set at two and one-half percent (2.5%):



SECTION 3: The provisions of this ordinance and the amendments to the tax code adopted hereby shall become effective October 1, 1991 and shall revert to 2% on October 31, 1996.


