AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS,  
ARIZONA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 97 REDUCING THE MAXIMUM SIZE OF  
SIGNS AUTHORIZED THEREUNDER.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of  
San Luis, Arizona as follows:

**Section 1:** That Ordinance No. 97, adopted by the Council of  
the City of San Luis, Arizona on the 11th day of December, 1991  
establishes that the maximum size to be allowed for signs is 300  
square feet, and that said size shall be reduced to 72 square feet.

**Section 2:** That all provisions regarding the maximum size of  
any sign and all references to 300 square feet in said Ordinance  
No. 97 are hereby replaced and reduced to 72 square feet.

**Section 3:** That all other terms and conditions of Ordinance  
No. 97 not specifically amended herein are hereby reaffirmed in  
their entirety.

**Section 4:** That it is necessary for the preservation of the  
peace, health and safety of the City of San Luis, Arizona, an  
emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become  
immediately operative and in force from and after the date of  
posting hereof.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Council of the City  
of San Luis this 25<sup>th</sup> day of May 1994.


