ORDINANCE NO. 161

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, RELATING TO THE PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAX; ADOPTING "THE 1999 AMENDMENTS TO THE TAX CODE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS" BY REFERENCE; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDNATED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA:

Section 1: That certain document known as "The 1999 Amendments to the Tax Code of the City of San Luis," three copies of which are on file in the office of the city clerk of the City of San Luis, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 413 of the City of San Luis, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2: Except as provided in Section 3 and 4 of this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance and the public record adopted herein are effective from and after December 31, 1999.

Section 3: The following provisions of the public record adopted herein are retroactive to January 1, 1999:

- (a) Subsection (b)(3) of Section 415.
- (b) Subsection (c)(1)(A) of Section 416.
- (c) Subsection (b)(1)(A) of Section 417.

Section 4: The following provisions of the public record adopted herein are retroactive to May 5, 1999:


- (a) Subsection (c)(10) of Section 450.
- (b) Subsection (kk) of Section 465.
- (c) Subsection (kk) of Section 660.

Section 5: Any person found guilty of violating any provision of these amendments to the tax code shall be guilty of a class one misdemeanor. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense punishable as herein above described.


Section 6: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance or any part of these amendments to the tax code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


