## Ordinance No. 205.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE SAN LUIS CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE CITY CODE BY MODIFYING SECTION 10-5-2 (I), OF THE SAN LUIS CITY CODE, DEFINITIONS. RELOCATING THE TAXI STAND FROM THE SOUTH SIDE OF "A" STREET TO THE NORTH SIDE OF "A" STREET, IN THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis wished to relocate the "Taxi Stand" from the south side of "A" Street to the north side of "A" Street.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1** that Article 10-5-2 (I) TRANSPORTATION BUSINESS REGULATIONS DEFINITIONS is hereby deleted in its entirety and hereby replaced and added to the City Code as follows:

**I. "TAXI STAND"** The portion of the north side of "A" Street beginning at forty (40) feet from the east edge of Main Street and ending at sixty (60) feet from the beginning, shall be designated as a taxi stand. All taxicabs shall park with its right side wheels no more than eight (8) inches from the curb.

**Section 2 SEVERABILITY** If any sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance or any part of the code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**Section 3 CONFLICTS** All ordinances and parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or any part of the section of code adopted herein, are hereby repealed.

**Section 4 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY** Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of San Luis, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative and enforced on and after the date of adoption by the council of the City of San Luis, Arizona.


