ORDINANCE NO. 209

An Ordinance of the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona Amending the Purchasing Policies of the City of San Luis; Repealing Any Conflicting Provisions; And Providing for Severability.

Whereas, the City of San Luis desires to amend its purchasing policies as contained in its City Code;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, State of Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: Article 3-4 Purchasing, of the City Code as adopted by Ordinance No. 88 is hereby repealed, superceded, and replaced.

Section 2: Article 3-4 of the City Code is hereby amended to read as set forth in that certain document entitled "Article 3-4 City Procurement," three (3) copies of which are on file with the City Clerk, and which is hereby adopted by reference as though fully set forth again in full.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy regarding the purchasing policies of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superceded, and replaced, and the provisions of this Ordinance and "Article 3-4 City Procurement," shall govern.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


