ORDINANCE NO. 219

An Ordinance of the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona Amending the Purchasing Policies of the City of San Luis; Providing for Effective Date; Repealing Any Conflicting Provisions; Providing for Severability; and Declaring an Emergency

Whereas, the City of San Luis desires to amend its purchasing policies as contained in its City Code;

Whereas, it is important for purposes of fiscal responsibility to have an effective purchasing policy that is capable of being administered in an efficient manner, and allow for implementation of policies and goals and the efficient and timely acquisition and delivery of goods and services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, State of Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: Those portions of the City Code as previously adopted regulating purchasing, including those adopted by Ordinance No. 209, are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced.


Section 2: The City Code is hereby amended to read as set forth in that certain document entitled "Purchasing Policy Procedures 2005," three (3) copies of which are on file with the City Clerk, and which is hereby adopted by reference as though fully set forth again in full.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy regarding the purchasing policies of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this Ordinance and the "Purchasing Policy Procedures 2005" shall govern. The Purchasing Policy Procedures 2005 shall govern all purchases and city contracts from and after June 30, 2004.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5: Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of San Luis, Arizona, and for further reason that pending purchases, financial considerations, and the best interest of the City require the amendments to go into immediate effect, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative and in force from and after the date of posting hereof.


