ORDINANCE NO. 262

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AMENDING SECTION 10-5-2 (I) OF THE SAN LUIS CITY CODE BY MODIFYING THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM “TAXI STAND”; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That Article 10-5-2 Transportation Business Definitions of the San Luis City Code is hereby amended by amending Section 10-5-2 (I) “Taxi Stand” to read as follows:

I. “Taxi Stand” Such portions of right of way within the City limits of the City of San Luis, Arizona that may be designated by the Director of the Department of Public Safety as and for a taxi stand. Such portions of right of way shall be marked by the Department of Public Works as being reserved for use by taxis. Any such portions of right way so designated as and for a taxi stand shall be designated with the approval of the City Engineer and the Director of Public Works.

Section 2: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


