ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AMENDING THE CITY CODE BY AMENDING ARTICLE 10-5, TRANSPORTATION BUSINESS REGULATIONS, SECTION 10-5-5, INDIVIDUAL OPERATOR'S PERMIT REQUIRED, SUBSECTION 10-5-5.B.2 REGARDING THE SUSPENSION OF A DRIVERS LICENSE AND THE ISSUANCE OF AN INDIVIDUAL OPERATOR'S PERMIT TO OPERATE A VEHICLE IN THE TRANSPORTATION BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF SAN LUIS; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:


Section 1: Section 10-5-5 of the City Code of the City of San Luis, Arizona, Individual Operator's Permit Required, is hereby amended by amending subsection 10-5-5.B.2 regarding the issuance of an Individual Operator's Permit to read as follows:

2. Had his or her driver's license suspended, revoked, or canceled for any reason within the past six months.

Section 2: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


