# *Ordinance* ORDINANCE NO. 273

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AMENDING ARTICLE 10-7, TOWING, SECTION 10-7-3 SUBSECTION 10-7-3.H.2 DEALING WITH MAXIMUM FEES FOR TOWING AND STORAGE; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

Whereas Ordinance No. 202 of the City of San Luis added Article 10-7 Towing to the City Code of the City of San Luis, Arizona;

Whereas Subsection 10-7-3.H.2 of the City Code of the City of San Luis provides that City Council may establish maximum fees for towing and storage by resolution;

Whereas on February 11, 2009 the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona adopted Resolution No. 817 which established new maximum fees for towing and storage and set the fee for storage to be based on a 24 four hour day; and

Whereas it is desired to clarify and make certain what is meant by a 24 hour day:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:


**Section 1:** Subsection 10-7-3.H.2 of the City Code of the City of San Luis is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. The maximum fees shall be \$75.00 for towing and \$25.00 per twenty-four (24) hour day for storage. The twenty-four hour period is to begin upon the towing of the vehicle. As an example, for illustrative purposes only, if a vehicle is towed on a Wednesday at 1:30 p.m., the maximum charge for storage shall be limited to \$25.00 until 1:30 p.m. on Thursday. The fees may be changed by subsequent resolution of the San Luis City Council.

**Section 2:** In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

**Section 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


