AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AMENDING SECTION 10-5-6(C)(1) OF THE CITY CODE TO CHANGE THE AMOUNT OF TRANSPORTATION BUSINESS VEHICLE PERMIT FEE; ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas Section 10-5-6 (C) (1) of the City Code provides for an annual Transportation Business Vehicle License Fee in the amount of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per vehicle; and

Whereas there is a desire to provide financial relief to Transportation Business Operators and have this immediately effective for calendar year 2011;

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That the amount of the annual Transportation Business Vehicle License Permit Fee as provided by Section 10-5-6 (C) (1) of the City Code of the City of San Luis is hereby amended to be the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per vehicle. This change in the amount of the annual fee shall be effective as of January 1, 2011. All other provisions of Section 10-5-6 (C) (1) shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2: City staff shall take such acts or actions as may be necessary to effectuate this ordinance.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5: Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of San Luis, Arizona, and for further reason that the best interest of the City require the amendment to Section 10-5-6 (C) (1) go into immediate effect so that the impact of financial relief to an important element in public transportation services is immediate and occurs in a manner so as to not create confusion or unnecessary burdens on public administration, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance and the amendment adopted pursuant to its provisions shall become immediately operative and in force from and after the date of posting hereof.


