

R E S O L U T I O N N o . 1 9

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING A BASIS FOR COMPUTING WAGES FOR WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE PREMIUM PAYMENTS AND COMPENSATION BENEFITS FOR VOLUNTEER FIREMEN OF THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 23-901 4(d) now defines "employee" within the meaning of the Workmen's Compensation laws of the State of Arizona to include volunteer firemen serving as members of a volunteer fire department of an incorporated town, even though the same may be serving without pay or without full pay and on a part-time basis, and

WHEREAS, said statute does further provide that for the purposes of the Workmen's Compensation laws of the State of Arizona the basis for computing wages for Workmen's Compensation insurance premium payments and compensation benefits for such volunteer firemen shall be the salary equal to the beginning salary of the same rank or grade in the full time service with the town or volunteer fire department, and

WHEREAS, said statute further provides that if there is no full time equivalent, then the salary equivalent shall be as determined by resolution of the governing body of the town, and

WHEREAS, within the Town of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona, there is no such full time equivalent service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, as follows:

Section 1. That solely for the purpose of arriving at a basis for computing wages for Workmen's Compensation insurance premium payments and Workmen's Compensation benefits for volunteer firemen of the Volunteer Fire Department of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, the Town Council does by this resolution determine such volunteer firemen's salary to be \$500.00 per month.

Section 2. That the Town Manager be, and he is hereby authorized, and directed to provide the Arizona State Compensation Fund with such information as they may require including the names and addresses of the firemen so serving as volunteer firemen of the Volunteer Fire Department of the Town of San Luis.


Section 3. Whereas, the immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor

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and Council of the Town of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona, and it is hereby exempt from the referendum provisions of the Constitution and laws of the State of Arizona.
