

RESOLUTION NO. 99

RESOLUTION ORDERING AND CALLING A SPECIAL BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD IN AND FOR THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA ON SEPTEMBER 24, 1985 TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS THEREOF THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF UP TO AND INCLUDING \$1,200,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA STREET AND HIGHWAY USER REVENUE BONDS, PROJECT OF 1985.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA:

Section 1. That a special street and highway user revenue bond election in the Town of San Luis, Arizona, hereinafter referred to as the "Town", be and the same is hereby called to be held on September 24, 1985 at the following precinct and polling place:

The polling place will be open at 6:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

Absentee voting shall be permitted in accordance with the provisions of Title 16, Chapter 4, Article 8, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended. A qualified elector may vote absentee if: (1) the elector expects to be absent from the Town or his voting precinct at the time of holding the election; (2) the elector is physically unable to go to the polls; (3) the elector is 65 years of age or older; (4) the elector's place of residence is more than 15 road miles from the polling

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, AZ. AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS AND CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION MEETS THE LOW-AND MODERATE BENEFIT REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG program requires that 60% of CDBG funds requested benefit low-and moderate-income persons for activities justified or benefiting low-and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG program requires that 51% of CDBG funds requested benefit low-and moderate-income persons for activities justified or aiding in the prevention or elimination of blight; and

WHEREAS, A GRANTEE OF State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of San Luis authorizes application to be made to the State of Arizona, Office of Economic Planning and Development for CDBG funds, and authorizes the Mayor to sign application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds; and

THAT this application for State CDBG funds meets the requirements of low-and moderate-income benefits for activities justified or benefiting low-and moderate-income persons and for activities justified as aiding in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight; and




